



Full Time Acting Counselor:

Seeking an enthusiastic acting counselor for all weeks of Camp JuMP to work with kids ages 6-14. Looking for an experienced thespian who is good at connecting with kids and building relationships with them.

Acting Counselor Job Description:

Acting Counselor Requirements:

- Extensive acting skill and experience
- Have a firm knowledge of the following acting concepts, including: stage directions, projection, diction, stage presence, and physical and vocal character choices.
- Passion for theatre and working with other creatives
- Excellent attention to detail
- Great interpersonal and collaborative communication abilities
- Be a good Christian role model
- NOT a requirement, but favorable: pursuing a degree in theatre in higher education

Acting Counselor Duties:

- Independently lead a group of up to 10 kids in acting games
- Run scenes that the director has already blocked with the campers, and be able to offer basic acting tips that fit with the director's vision.
- Attend all staff camp hours with a positive attitude. All staff is expected to pitch in to meet the needs of camp, and which may occasionally require working past official staff hours as needs arise - particularly in the first session of the Broadway Jr. camp.
- Be available for a Counselor Planning meeting prior to auditions and for a Staff Planning meeting prior to the first week of camp
- Lead acting games as directed
- Follow the schedule as provided by the director
- Help in light set construction

- Assist in creating camper awards
- Assist in putting microphones on campers
- Help campers get into costumes and makeup if necessary
- Serve on tech crew during the performances
- Rehearse scenes and solos with campers
- Ensure all costumes are hung up properly
- Help prepare the house for the performances
- Help set up and execute Color Wars games
- Help move in for Scrapped and Broadway Jr.
- Help reset on Friday night for the show Saturday
- Help reset for the next week of camp after the show Saturday
- Help move out of the church after the conclusion of Scrapped and Broadway Jr. Session 3
