



VIDEO AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAMPERS

Something Rotten Jr. and Scrapped

For auditions, all cast members must prepare and memorize an audition song corresponding to their camp week (Broadway Jr. or Scrapped). Audition songs are 30 second cuts from the show, and must be performed with the corresponding instrumental track. There is a selection of audition tracks to choose from on our website, where all audition tracks are available to view and download.

Before Filming:

- Make sure to have two devices accessible: one to play the music, and one to video record
- Ask an assistant to video/play music for the video audition.

Video Requirements:

- Please take the video HORIZONTALLY.
- Please video from the **waist up**
- At the beginning of the audition video, slate (introduce yourself) with the following information:
 1. Name
 2. Age
 3. One interesting fact about yourself
 4. A brief description of any performance experience you may have, if applicable
 5. What song you are singing.
- In the same video, sing your prepared audition song, with the instrumental version of the selected audition soundtrack.

Slate example: “My name is Lucy, and I am 12 years old. An interesting fact about me is that I have never broken a bone. I have performed in 3 shows with my school. I am singing _____.”

After Filming:

- Upload audition video to YouTube as an **Unlisted** Link and submit via Submission Form.
- Upload your video on our website by **Sunday, MAY 3rd.**

Audition Tracks and Information

All campers must choose one of the audition tracks to sing for auditions. Audition tracks are short cuts of songs from the show. Audition vocal and instrumental tracks are linked in the Cast Resources page of our website. Campers will sing with the instrumental track at auditions. If your child is participating in both Scrapped and Broadway Jr., they will need to attend both camp specific audition time slots and prepare two audition songs.

We are looking for campers to be confident and ACT the part while they are singing!

All audition songs for Broadway Jr. are delineated by character, with a suggested age for campers who are most likely to be cast in these roles. Please note that not all characters in the show with solos have an audition song. It may benefit more experienced campers to familiarize themselves with a few audition songs in advance, in the event they may be called back and asked to sing a different song. We strive to make auditions a fun part of the camp process, so we encourage campers to be themselves and have fun!
